As the RTD Light Rail system continues to expand, so do the transportation options. Whether you are a commuter or student, shopper or sports fan, tourist or resident, light rail provides more options for fast, convenient and affordable travel.

The RTD Light Rail system provides fast, (up to 55 mph) comfortable and reliable transportation through the Central, Southwest and Southeast metro areas. Once you've tried it, you'll find how easy it is to ride light rail. Just hop on board and enjoy the ride — without the hassle and expense of driving and parking.

Riding Light Rail is as Easy as A, B, C and D

The RTD Light Rail system is divided into four fare zones. Light rail fares are determined by the number of zones a passenger travels in for each one-way trip. If a passenger travels in one-two adjacent zones, it is considered local travel and is a local fare. Three-zone adjacent travel is an express fare and four-zone travel is a regional fare.

Most light rail stations have park-n-Ride lots where you can park your car for free. In addition, many stations are served by convenient bus routes that circulate throughout nearby neighborhoods. How to Select your Light Rail Fare

Cash Fare Customers

Before boarding, purchase light rail tickets at the ticket vending machines located at the light rail stations. The ticket vending machines are programmed to automatically calculate the correct fare based on the selected destination.

Monthly Pass Customers

Local Monthly Pass (AB, BC, CD)

Local monthly pass holders should select either an AB, BC or CD pass at the time of purchase, depending on their travel pattern. If a selection is not made, the pass holder automatically receives a Local AB pass.

If traveling to an adjacent zone not listed on the monthly pass, a **zone receipt** must be obtained at a ticket vending machine located at the light rail station.

For example: Local AB pass holder travels from zone B to C, or a BC pass holder travels from zone C to D. This is local travel (two-zone travel) as long as the pass holder only travels in a maximum of two adjacent zones. Both the zone receipt and monthly pass should be shown to the fare inspector.

An **upgrade** is needed when a Local pass holder travels in more than two zones. *For example: Local AB pass holder travels from zone A to C. The number of zones traveled is three zones and the pass holder must purchase an upgrade prior to boarding at the ticket vending machine located at the light rail station.*

Pass holders pay only the difference between a two-zone fare and a three-zone fare. Both the upgrade and monthly pass should be shown to the fare inspector.

Express Monthly Pass (ABC, BCD)

Express monthly pass holders should select an ABC or BCD pass at the time of purchase, depending on their primary travel. If a selection is not made, the pass holder automatically receives an Express ABC pass.

If traveling to an adjacent zone not listed on the monthly pass, a **zone receipt** must be obtained at a ticket vending machine located at the light rail station. *For example: Express ABC pass holder travels from zone B to zone D or BCD pass holder travels from zone C to zone A. This is express travel (three-zone travel) as long as the pass holder only travels in a maximum of three adjacent zones. Both the zone receipt and monthly pass should be shown to the fare inspector.*

An **upgrade** is needed when an Express pass holder travels in more than three zones. *For example: Express BCD pass holder travels from zone D to A. The number of zones traveled is four zones and the pass holder must purchase an upgrade prior to boarding at the ticket vending machine located at the light rail station. Pass holders pay only the difference between a three-zone fare and a four-zone fare. Both the upgrade and monthly pass should be shown to the fare inspector.*

Regional Monthly Pass (ABCD)

Regional monthly passes are valid for travel in four zones; ABCD.
